

## Point Calculations

The Area 3 year-end points are calculated when organizers send their final results to the Points Chair. Area 3 points are only awarded to Area 3 members participating in Area 3 recognized events. (Membership is determined by the address on file with the USEA.)

Points are determined by the number of competitors starting each division. Points are given for Advanced, Intermediate, Preliminary, Jr/YR Preliminary, Senior Training, Junior Training, Senior Novice, Junior Novice, Senior Beginner Novice, and Junior Beginner Novice.

Leading Rider and Leading Young Rider of the Year are determined at the end of the year by the number of total points accumulated by each rider on every horse ridden and at every level (BN-A).

The points are awarded as follows:
