

For a Sponsored Summer Camp with Kim Severson!



Though Kim needs little introduction, she is one of the top event riders in the world. Throughout her career, she has been described as one of the most prolific riders in the United States and was named the USEA's Lady Rider of the Year in 2001, 2002, 2004, and 2005.

Most recently, Kim has produced Cooley Cross Border to top placings both in the US and abroad capping off their 2017 season with a win at the Blenheim Palace CCI3*! Other notable career accomplishments include WINS at Kentucky in 1999 with Over the Limit, and again in 2002, 2004, and 2005 aboard Winsome Adante. Additionally, she earned an individual silver medal and a team bronze medal at the Olympics in Athens in 2004. Prior to that, in 2002 she was a member of the gold medal winning team at the World Equestrian Games.

In addition to her personal accomplishments ON the horse, Kim has coached some of America's top riders and has had many adult amateurs in the top placings at numerous competitions. As a seasoned Olympian, Kim brings a unique and understanding approach to educating horses and riders of all levels. She is a master of the sandbox (most recently breaking the FEI record for lowest CIC3* score with a 20.8 at the Carolina International), a technician in the show jumping, and extremely accurate across the country.

Please join us in welcoming her for a 5-day camp to include a day of show jumping exercises/grids, show jumping coursework, cross country, and a private lesson in the phase of your choice at The Vista in Aiken. In addition, S dressage judge Sandy Osborn will provide a "ride-a-test" format private lesson for you to hone your skills between the boards under the scrutiny of a Senior dressage judge and accomplished Grand Prix rider.

WHEN: May 28 - June 2, 2018

WHERE: The Vista, 859 Old Tory Trail, **Aiken**, SC 29803

An easily accessible complete training facility consisting of a large all-weather riding arena (with both a small and large dressage arena) boasting state of the art footing, a gallop track, and a fully irrigated XC schooling course with water complexes, bank complexes, ditches, narrows, and a host of other cross country obstacles BN-Int.

COST: \$650 per rider for current 2018 Adult Rider Members.

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES: \$25/night stabling at an adjacent facility (easily hackable + FREE primitive RV camping) Limited paddocks available also for \$15/day.

Rider accommodation is not included and should be sought independently, but camping is allowed at no cost (both locations have restrooms), and there are numerous local hotels.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE: Mon: SJ exercises, Tues: Privates, Wed: SJ courses, Thurs: Privates, Fri: XC

PLUS: *AR sponsored lunches each day, 2 potluck dinners, and 2 dinners sponsored by AR at local facilities.*
